

Hello Friends and Neighbors,

I hope that this summer season finds you happy and well. I am writing to you a few days after my birthday. I have received many well wishes from many of you, and I am thankful for all your blessings. But, enough about me.

May is always an interesting month since both Ascension of Christ and Pentecost are celebrated in the same month. Christ is raised and received at the Father's side, while God's Holy Spirit is sent to the church to unite and empower us for the great work of ministry in the world. In the Book of Acts, the church begins with excitement and spreads not just through the disciple's home nation but to others throughout the world. But note that the spread of the ministry did not begin until the disciples spent time to "wait on the Lord." Capital Campaign Update

Thanks to the generous contributions from many people to the Capital Campaign, the building repairs have continued. This month most of the outside windows trim has been covered with white aluminum, the kitchen fire suppression system has been updated, our backflow preventer has been replaced, and the final touches on the Steeple repair has been done. This is all in addition to the projects last year which included an update to the fire alarm system, 8 windows replaced, some elevator items that needed replacement, our slate roof repaired and one of the A/C units replaced. We still have some more outside work that will be done later this year which includes replacements of some doors, painting the wooden soffit and trim, and some parking lot repairs, so stayed tuned for the next update!







The Mission Committee would like to thank the many people who stayed after church on Sunday, April 23 to wrap utensils for the Trenton Area Soup Kitchen. We worked together to wrap 1,000 sets of utensils to send to TASK. Good work, YUMC.


WE ARE GOING CAMPING! June 9 -11 Youth, Young Adults and Families are invited to head to French Creek
