
This devotional has been created for every stage of life:






It will soon be pumpkin time again! Join us for pumpkin unloading on Saturday, October 11. We always have a fun time setting up the patch!

notes from the Belcher Room


The Trustees have been busy with multiple repairs this summer. The biggest repair this summer has been replacing the pumps and other components of the sewer lift station. This was a major repair that cost the church approximately \$20,000. We also repaired our roof, gutters, and did significant tree trimming and removal. We are currently working to put window well covers on the ground floor windows to prevent them from flooding during heavy rain. These repair costs were largely covered by a very generous donation from one of our members.

To meet Fire Department codes during a series of inspections, we have also replaced the outdated water hook-up valve below the stained-glass window, replaced bulbs and backup batteries in two of our EXIT signs. Thanks to the Ransoms we have a new emergency light in the Belcher room. We also have applied roof truss signs over three of our entrances to be compliant with FD code. Though not a finding from the FD inspection, the Ransoms also repaired broken electrical conduit running to our main A/C unit. Just to repair the A/C conduit took hours identifying the breakers for the unit!

This summer, during MyCalling!, the youth weeded, sanded and re-stained the gaga pit. The youth also replaced the roof on the youth storage shed. A big THANKS to the youth and adult leaders of MyCalling! for making our property look great!

And most recently we had the Nursery outside door lock repaired. Matt continues to work in room 005 and once finished he will turn his attention to some damaged ceiling tile in room 208. There's always something at the church that needs attention.


Sunday School Kick Off!!
